



## Superstition Airpark Arizona Model Aviators

The Arizona Model Aviators Maricopa County Recreational area is located in Eastern Maricopa County Arizona at grid coordinates 111.588030 / 33.442657.



### **LARGE EVENT COVID-19 RULES**

To participate in events over 50 people, Arizona Model Aviators in cooperation with Maricopa County have created these rules that all participants must agree to. The purpose of these rules are to insure the safety of those participating following CDC guidelines related to reducing and preventing the spread of COVID-19. If you are unable or unwilling to comply with these rules we kindly ask that you not attend as no exceptions will be made and no arguments will be entertained. These rules remain in effect for events over 50 people until instructed by Maricopa County. These rules apply to club members, visiting attendees, vendors and spectators equally.

#### **Access Requirements**

1. Vehicle access will remain the same whereby club members and visitors to the Airpark will enter Levee Road from Meridian Road. The posted speed limit of 10 MPH will remain in effect and would not change unless otherwise indicated by Maricopa County.
2. Vehicles will be parked to the south of the spectator area/aviation field as has been the established procedure with no implications or impact to spacing requirements.
3. Entry fees will be paid at the entrance to the park as been the established procedure. All exchange of currency will require the use of gloves by those members who are accepting money and rendering change to those entering. Those accepting money will stand on the driver-side of the vehicle in front of the mirror. Members working at the pay point are required to wear a mask if within 6 feet of other members or visitors.

#### **Pedestrian Entry Requirements**

1. All club members, participants, visitors, and event workers will enter the event area through a point that is structured in such a way as to assure all who enter are screened by the following procedure:
  - a. Temperature check with a thermal device that detects fever or elevated body temperature, and
  - b. mask wearing requirement is being complied with, and
  - c. completed the notification sheet with printed name and phone number, and
  - d. COVID questions are answered whereby those answers meet access criteria.

2. After a person has been checked for temperature, mask and answered NO to the screening questions they will be issued an indicator that they have met the entry requirements. (wrist band, ink stamp, etc.)

## **Spacing Requirements**

1. All visitors, club members, workers are required to maintain 6 feet separation in all areas to include:
  - a. Fence areas
  - b. Bleachers
  - c. Pilot Tables
  - d. Announcer stage and podium
  - e. Pilot Boxes
  - f. Rest areas
  - g. Lines to restrooms
2. Spectators must stand or sit where the colored indicators are so as to maintain 6 feet of separation.

## **Signage Placement**

1. Signs will be placed at all entry points to the PIT AREA that list COVID Spread prevention requirements. Each spread prevention sign shall include statements referring to:
  - a. Mask Requirement
  - b. 6 Feet Spacing Requirement
  - c. Stay at home if sick
  - d. Hand washing or sanitizing
  - e. Keeping hands away from eyes and face
  - f. Avoidance of sharing items
  - g. Notification if sick statement
  - h. Contact numbers for reporting

## **Hand Sanitizer Stations**

1. Hand sanitizer stations will be located at each entry point to the pit area, the break area, inside the porta-johns, and at each bleacher area.

2. Each hand sanitizer station will be accompanied by a sign indicating the availability/use.
3. Hand Sanitizer bottles will be maintained/serviced during and after event.
4. Hand Sanitizer solution will contain a minimum of 60% alcohol.

### **Disinfecting Stations**

1. Disinfecting stations will be located at the free table area, the entry/sign-in counter, the break area, and at three tables spaced within the pit area.
2. Disinfecting solution bottles will be maintained/serviced during and after the event.
3. Disinfecting solution SDS sheet will be on file at the sign-in area for review.
4. Disinfecting solution must be rated to kill corona viruses.

### **Sign-In Counter**

1. Sign-in counter will have a clear barrier with gap or opening for exchange of items.
2. Pens, stapler, tape dispensers will be disinfected/wiped before use by next person.

### **Porta-John Restrooms**

1. Porta-John restrooms will be sprayed with disinfecting spray at the beginning of the event and during the event when possible.

A Bottle of disinfection spray will be left in each Porta-John so users may spray surfaces at their discretion.

Effective communication is critical when the following conditions have been identified

### **Exposure & Overseas Travel:**

- If any AMA member or visitor has traveled overseas or have knowingly been exposed to COVID-19, they are prohibited from entering the Superstition Airpark until 14 days have passed and they are symptom-free.
- Additionally, Superstition Airpark agrees that if one of our members has been exposed to COVID-19 or has traveled overseas, the club will notify members through an "Airfield Environmental Alert" email, AMA web page, and text messaging.

## Availability of AMA COVID Response Team:

- If, due to the exposure or rapid spread of COVID, and the AMA is unable to meet the Event Protocol and Response obligations; the designated AMA representative will be contacted immediately to determine the best course of action. Resolutions may include the use of other club members, a modified event schedule or re-schedule, a reduction in operational hours, or closing the Airpark down.

## AMA Communication:

It is abundantly clear that we all must work together and watch out for each other to ensure best practices are followed, as described by health care professionals. In the spirit of cooperation, we will strive to keep lines of communication completely open. Please let the Superstition Airpark Arizona Model Aviators (AMA) point of contact know if any visitors or members fall ill with any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, runny nose, coughing). This will allow us to take appropriate steps for additional cleaning and provide appropriate notification to club members and visitors.

## How to return to the airpark after being positive for the virus:

- Club members with COVID-19 who have stayed home (home isolated) may return to the airpark under the following conditions:
  - If you will not/have not had a test to determine if you are still contagious, you may return to the airpark after these three (3) things have happened:
    1. You have not had a fever for at least 72 hours (this is three (3) full days of no fever without the use of medicine and/or fever reducers) **AND**
    2. Other symptoms have improved (for example, when you cough, or shortness of breath have improved) **AND**
    3. At least 10 days have passed since your symptoms first appeared
  - If you have/will be tested to determine if you are still contagious, you may return to the airpark after these three (3) things have happened:
    1. You no longer have a fever (without the use of medicine and/or fever reducers) **AND**
    2. Other symptoms have improved (for example, when you cough, or shortness of breath have improved)
