

USERY MOUNTAIN REGIONAL PARK ARIZONA MODEL AVIATORS EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

INCIDENT/ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

- All emergencies: call 911 immediately.
- Provide 911 with this information: Issue, name, age, gender, symptom's, location, phone number of person reporting accident.
- Inform the 911 operators that MCSO Deputies should also be notified.
- Report any accident to Maricopa County Sheriff's Dispatch Office at
- (602) 876-1011.
- Report any accident to the Park Supervisor, Entry Station and Nature Center.
- If not medical situation, but a deputy is needed call (602) 876-1011. (Non-Emergency Line).

EMERGENCY EVACUATION – FLOODING

Although inundation depths are expected to be shallow, low-lying areas and locations upstream of embankments may experience greater inundation depths. There are 2 major washes that feed the Signal Butte FRS (in addition to Bulldog Floodway) and both washes are on each side of the aviator facility, so regardless of the size of the storm when we think of impoundment levels, these washes are the real threat and have the ability to trap the members/participants should the one road become inundated/un-drivable. The facility is within the Signal Butte FRS flood pool so we cannot think of it as just Bulldog Floodway/basin. Personnel will not be on or in the vicinity of the Bulldog Floodway and will be familiar with this emergency evacuation plan in case of impoundment.

Upon notification of Maricopa County Usery Mountain Regional Park Supervisor, access / egress or evacuation of area may be implemented. In event of evacuation:

- Remove all personnel from the concession site.
- Remove all equipment or items to be evacuated that is floatable and not secured.
- Lock all entrances unto the concession site.
